WHAT'S AVAILABLE TO HELP CRIME VICTIMS?



Assisting victims doesn't just mean going to court.

The North Carolina Victim of Crime Act (Article 45, NCGS 15A-830) require law enforcement agencies as soon as practicable, but within 72 hours after identifying a victim covered by this Article, to provide the victim with the following information:

- ⇒ Availability of Medical Services.
- ⇒ Availability of Victim Compensation and Agency's address and phone number.
- ⇒ Address and phone number of the District Attorney's Office.
- ⇒ Contact information in case they have not been notified of an arrest within 6 months.
- ⇒ Information about the accuser's opportunity for pretrial release.
- ⇒ Contact information of an investigating agency employee whom the victim may call to find out whether the accused has been released from custody
