Monthly UCR Index Crime Report February 2011

Causative Factors:

Part I Crime for February 2011 was **26%** higher than February 2010 reported crimes. Part I Violent Offenses for February 2011, however was **17%** lower than February 2010 totals. February 2011 Part I Property crimes were **28%** higher than February 2010 reports.

Part I Violent Crime was lower due to only 5 violent offenses being reported during month. Violent Crime reports have been down for the last 3 months, adding to consistent lows in these types of crime.

Part I Property Crime was higher due to a **62%** increase in the number of burglaries reported versus those reported in February 2010. This is the first month in which burglaries reported were significantly higher than the previous year's monthly reports.

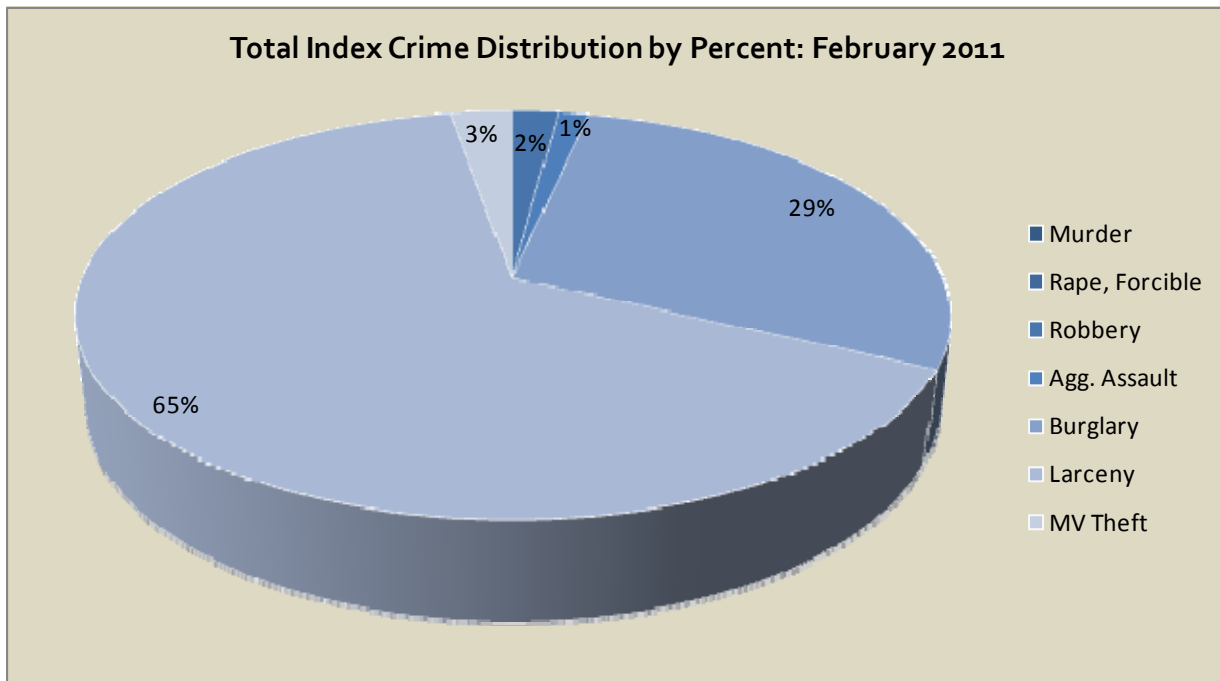
There was a **13%** increase in the number of larcenies reported during February '11 versus February '10. Shoplifting offenses were up **43%** increase; however Felony larceny from motor vehicle offenses were down **58%** and down **47%** 2011 YTD. **This is the 4th month in a row that these offenses have been down.**

February 2011 UCR Analysis

- Feb '10 to Feb '11 Month to Month Comparison Part 1 Crime is **up 26%**.
- Feb '10 to Feb '11 Month to Month Violent Crime is **down 17%** & Property Crime is **up 28%**.
- Total arrests are **up 9%** and warrant service arrests YTD are **down 2%**.

Of **147** Part I UCR Crimes reported in February '11;

Highest Crime: **96** Larcenies were reported equaling **65%** of reported UCR.

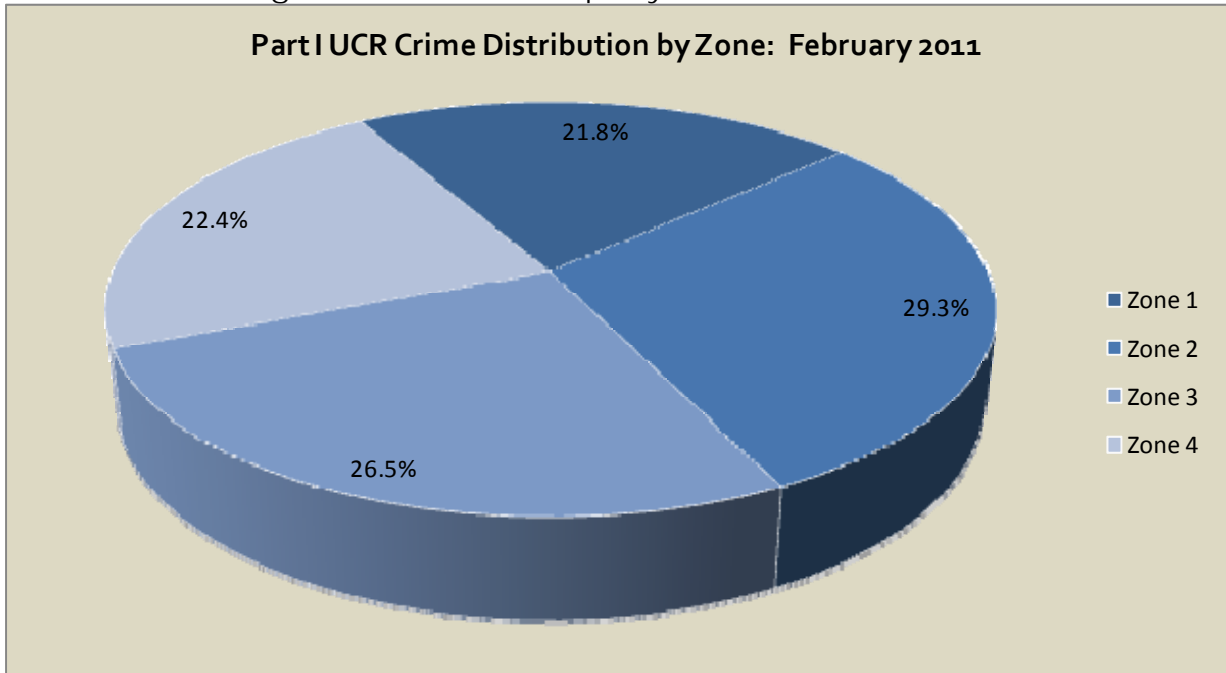

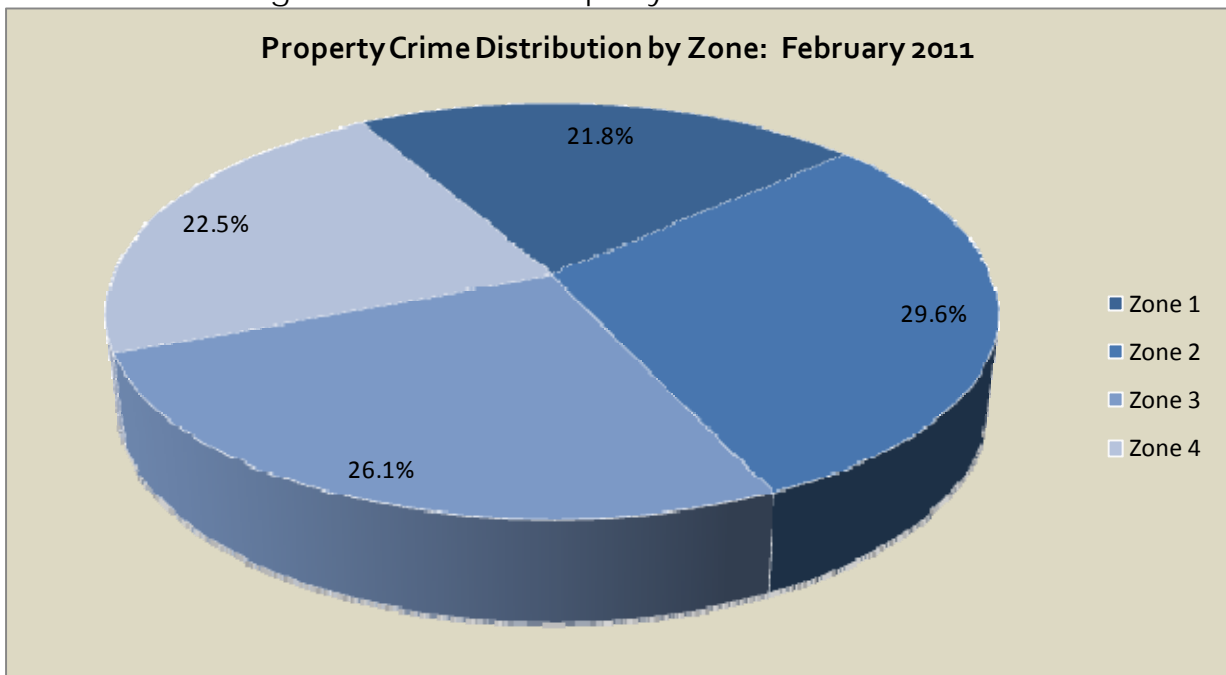
The **147** Part I UCR Crimes reported in February '11 are distributed by percent in zones as follows:

Zone 2 had the highest amount of Property Crimes at **29.3%**

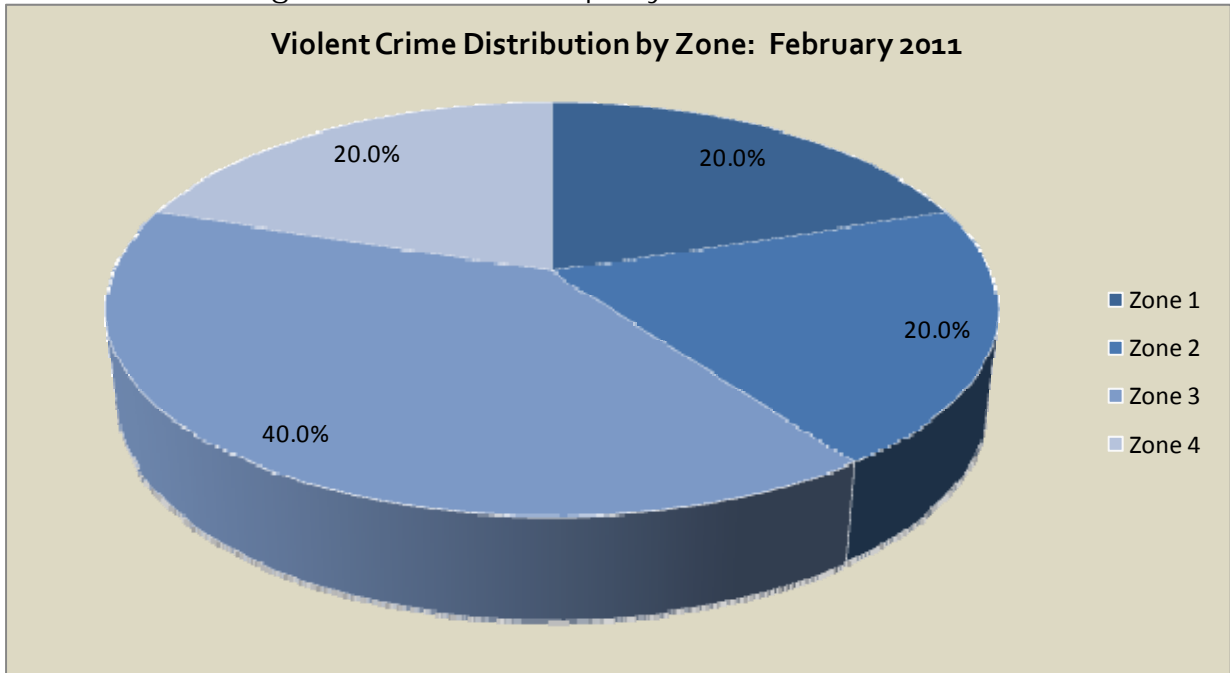


142 Property Crimes reported were distributed by Zone as follows:

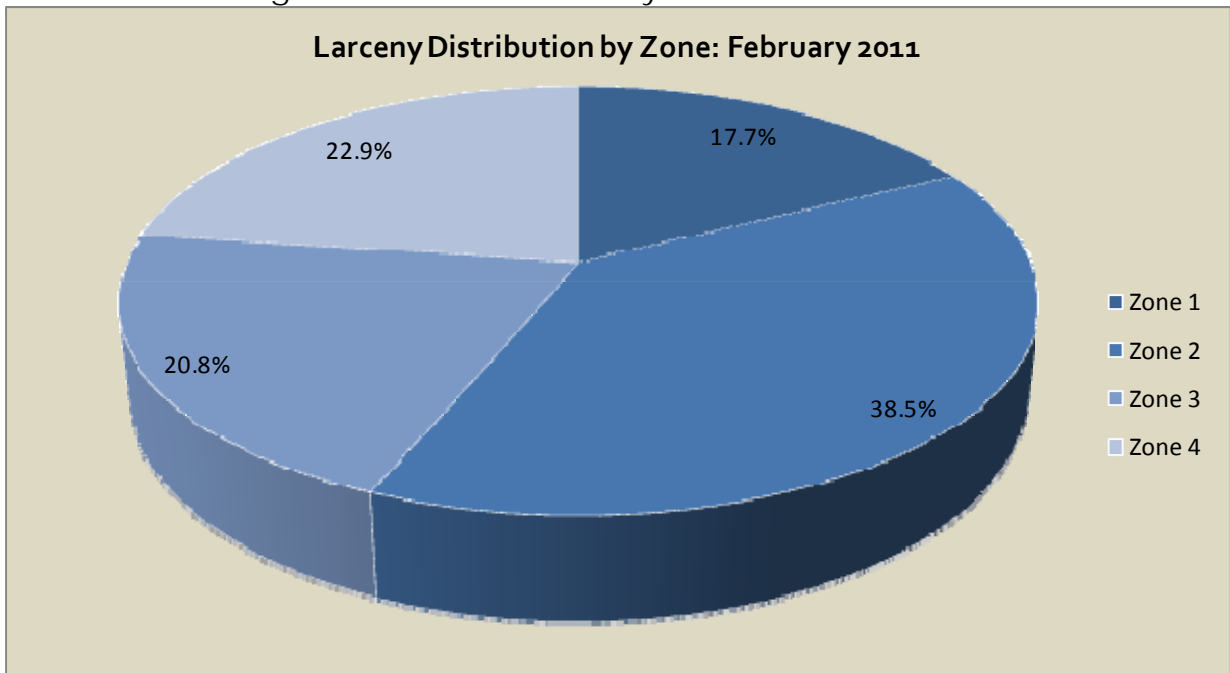
Zone 2 had the highest amount of Property Crimes at **29.6%**



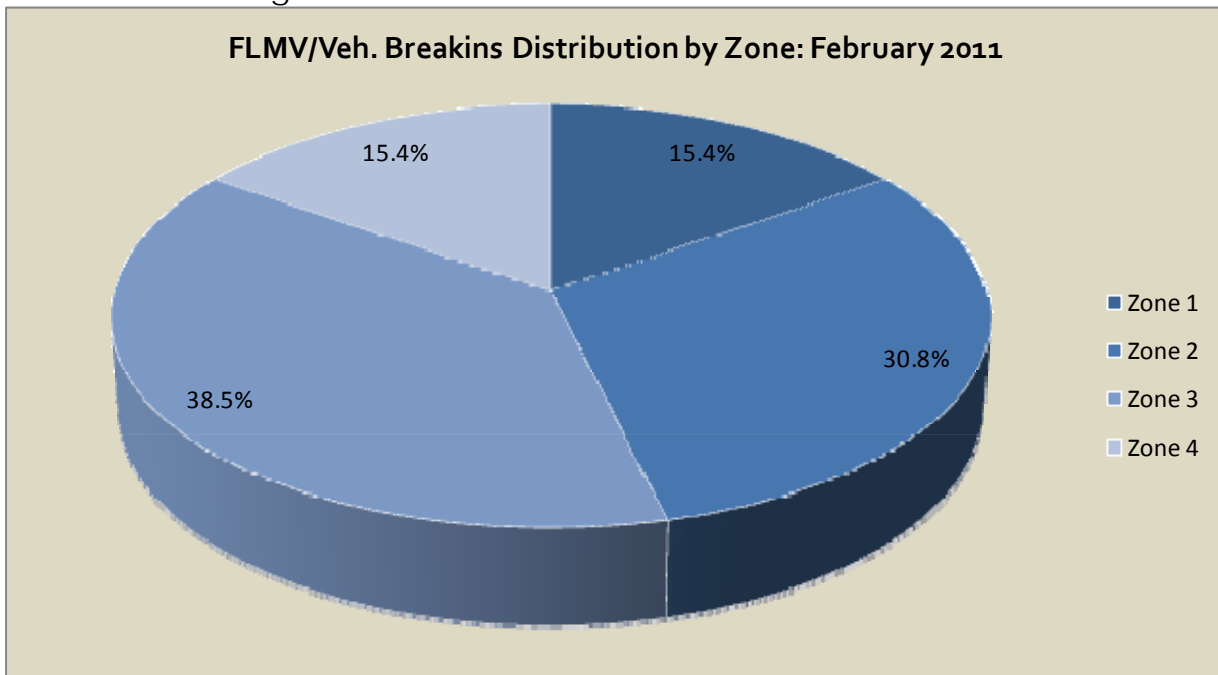
5 Violent Crimes reported were distributed by Zone as follows:
Zone 3 had the highest amount of Property Crimes at **40%**



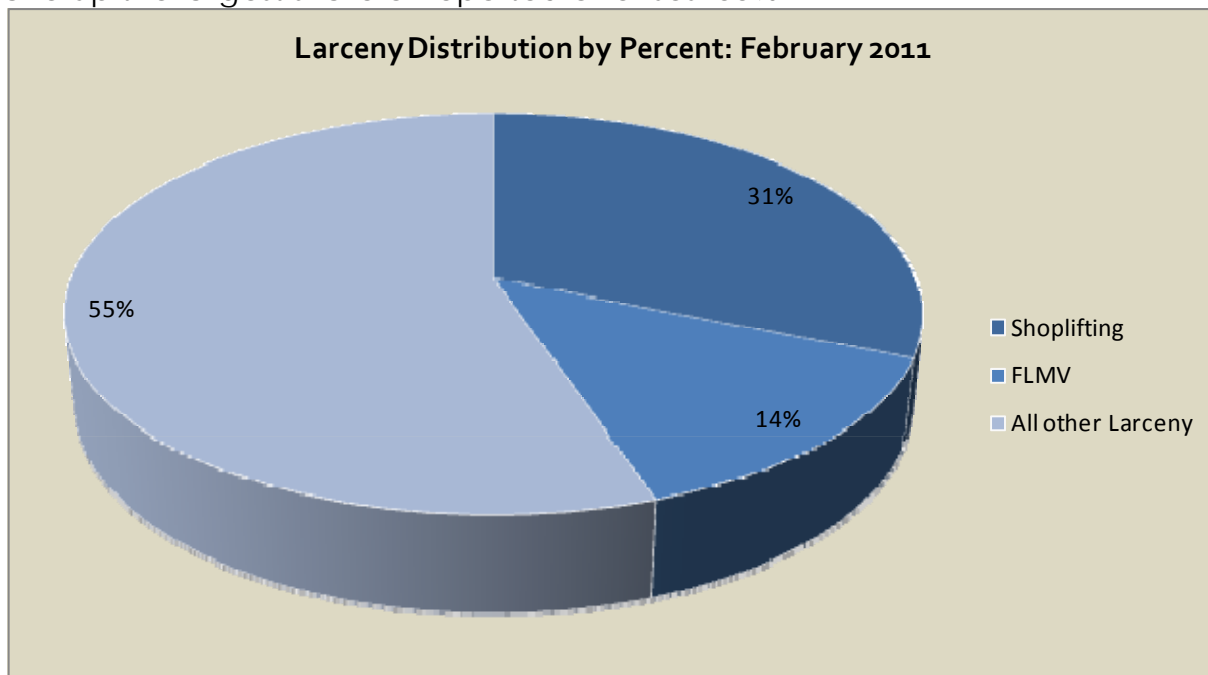
The **96** Larcenies reported in February '11 are distributed as follows:

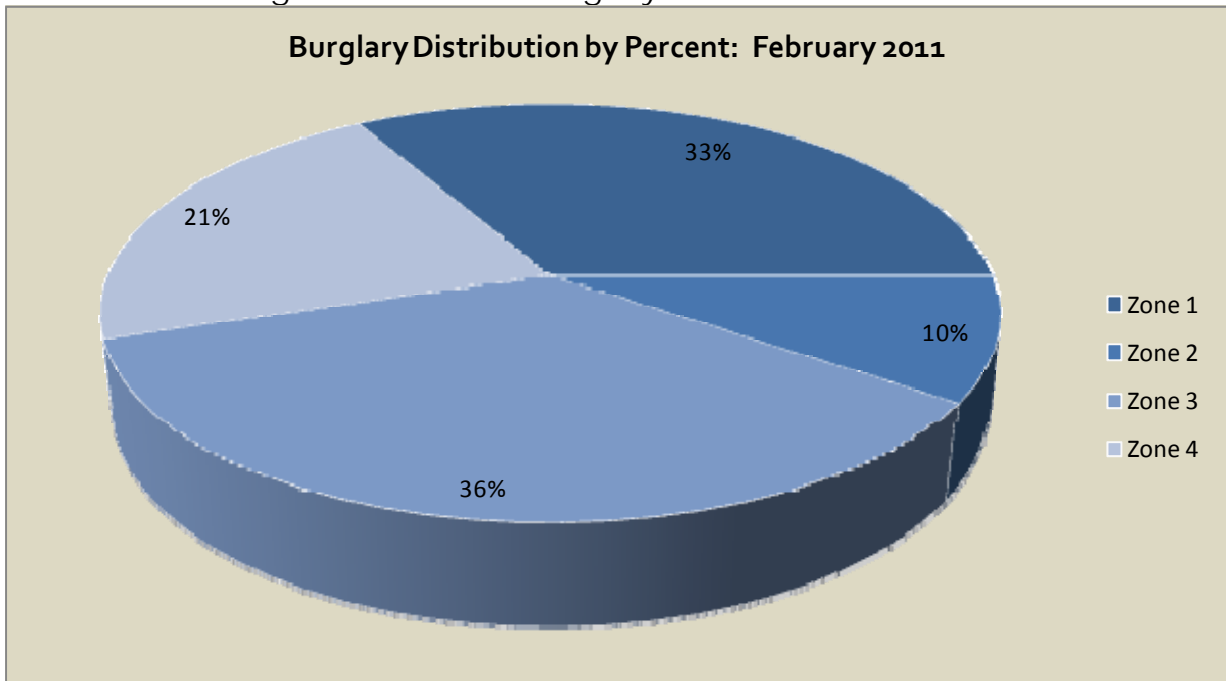


The **96** larcenies reported in February '11, larcenies coded as all other Larceny make up the largest share of reported offenses: **55%**

The majority of crashes are occurring in daylight hours (77%) and in dry (82%) and clear (77%) conditions.

Contributing Factors:

The main contributing causes of crashes was : No contributing circumstances indicated (35.51%)

The 2nd most contributing causes of crashes was : Improper Backing (15.94%)

The 3rd most contributing causes of crashes was : Inattention (12.32%)

The 4th most contributing causes of crashes was : Other (11.59%)
