Monthly UCR Index Crime Report March 2011

Causative Factors:

Part I Crime for March 2011 was **3%** higher than March 2010 and **19%** higher than Feb 2011 reported crimes. Part I Violent Offenses for March 2011 were **69%** higher than March 2010 totals. These offenses which include a homicide and rape are the most violent crime reported in the last three months. March 2011 Part I Property crimes were **3%** lower than March 2010 reports.

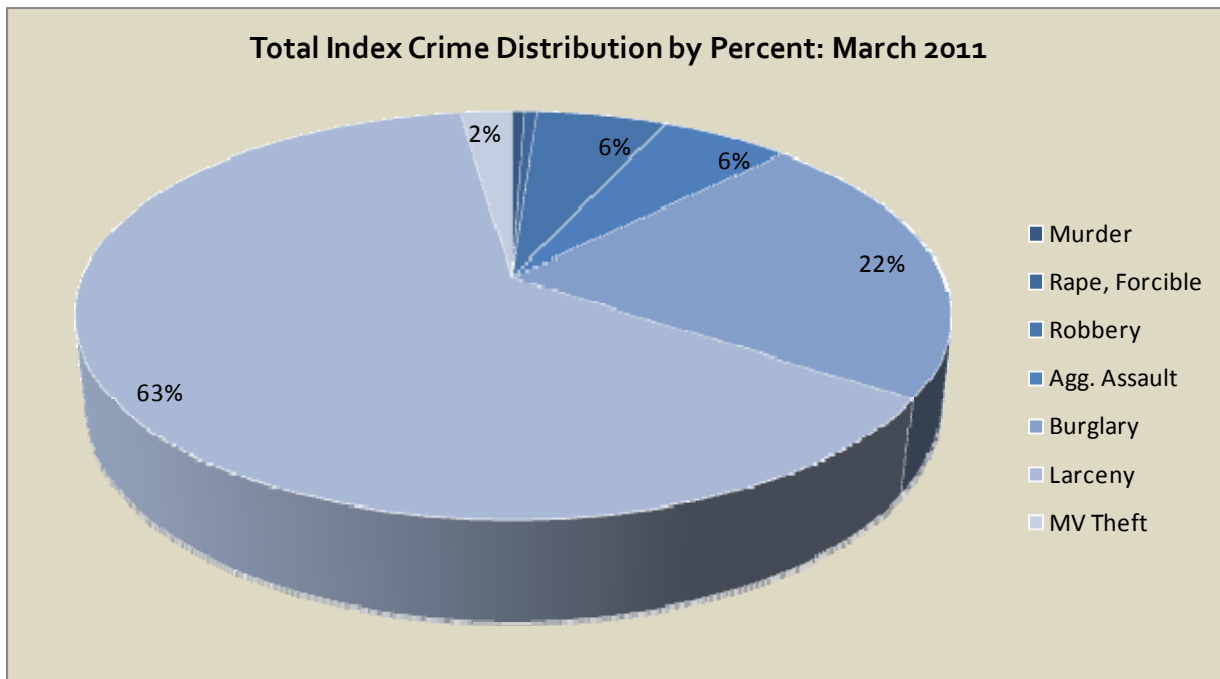
Part I Property Crime was lower due to a **19%** decrease in the number of burglaries reported versus those reported in March 2010. These are the lowest number of burglary reports since Jan 2011. There was a **6%** increase in the number of larcenies reported during March 2011 versus March 2010 and a **16%** increase over Feb 2011 reports. Shoplifting offenses were up **106%**; however Felony larceny from motor vehicle offenses were down **29%** and are down **40%** 2011 YTD. This is the **5th** month in a row that these FLMV offenses have been down versus the previous year's numbers. However all other larceny reports are up **24%** over 2010 YTD totals.

March 2011 UCR Analysis

- Mar '10 to Mar '11 Month to Month Comparison Part 1 Crime is **up 3%**.
- Mar '10 to Mar '11 Month to Month Violent Crime is **up 69%** & Property Crime is **down 3%**.
- Total arrests are **up 17%** and warrant service arrests YTD are **down 2%**.

Of **175** Part I UCR Crimes reported in March '11;

Highest Crime: **111** Larcenies were reported equaling **63%** of reported UCR.

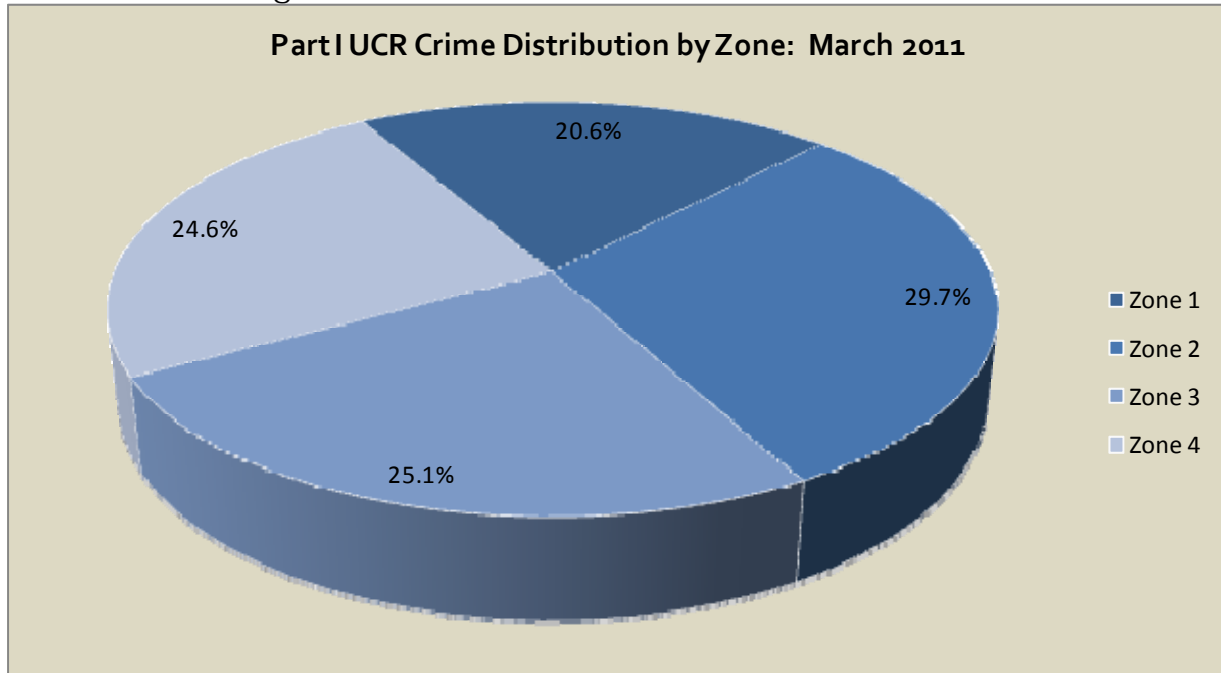

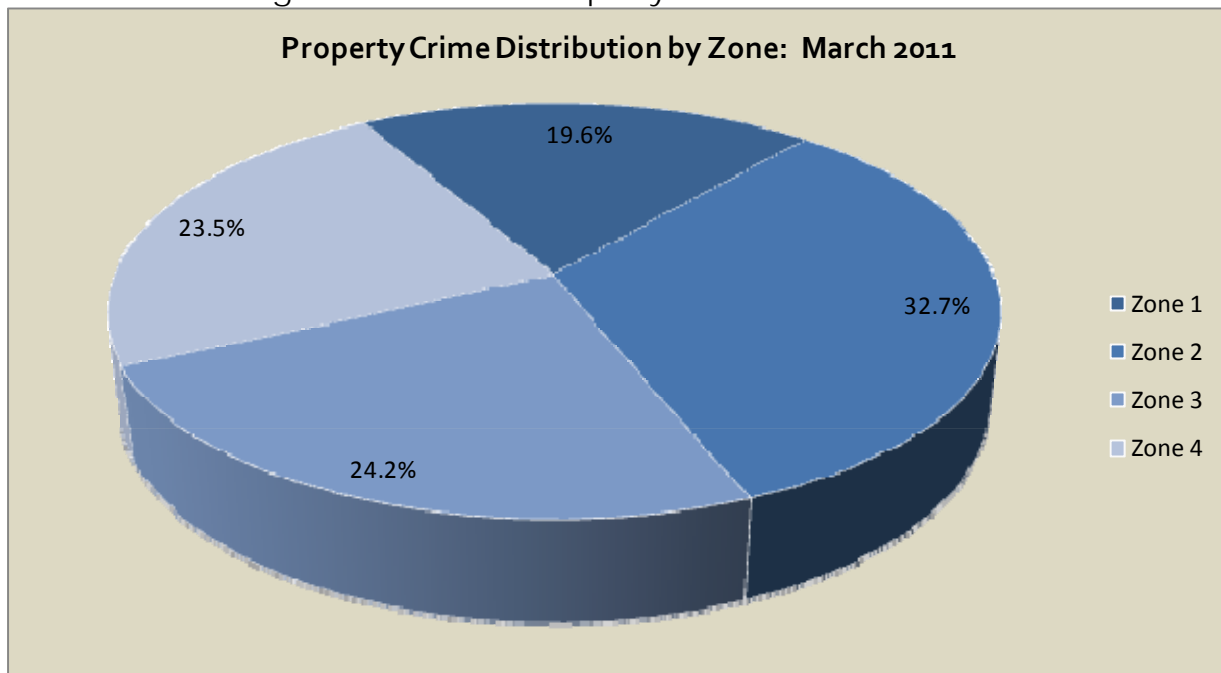
The **175** Part I UCR Crimes reported in March '11 are distributed by percent in zones as follows:

Zone 2 had the highest amount of Part I UCR Crimes at **29.7%**

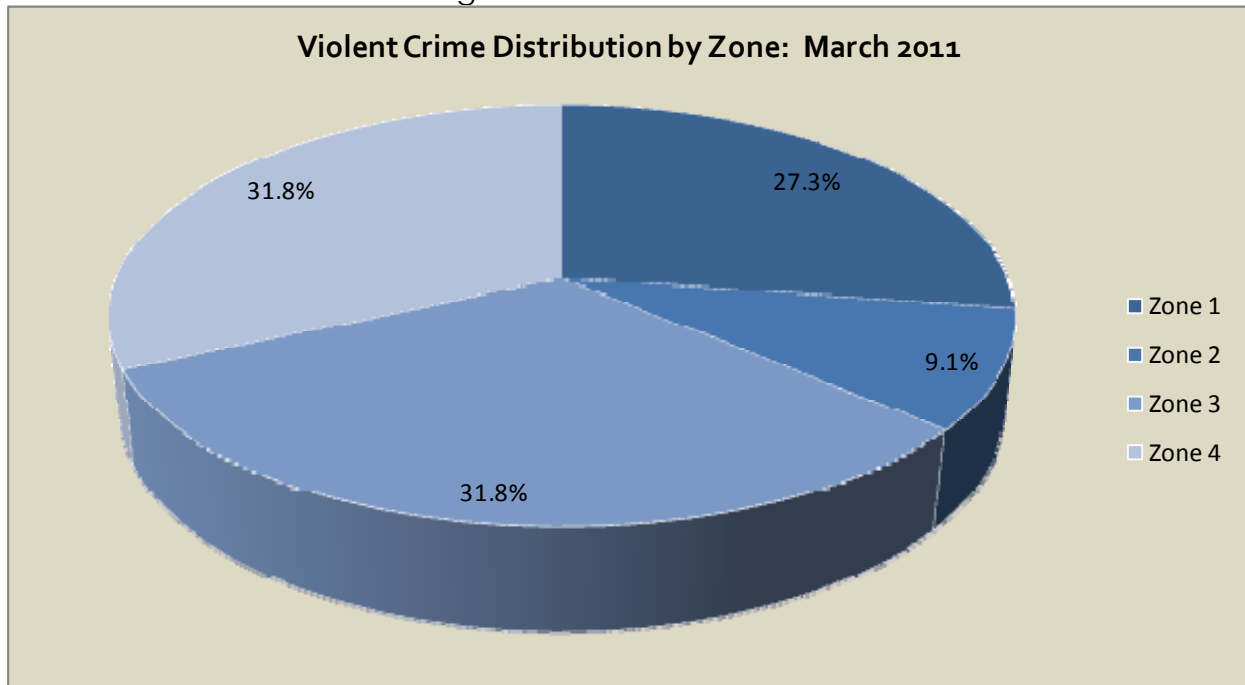


153 Property Crimes reported were distributed by Zone as follows:

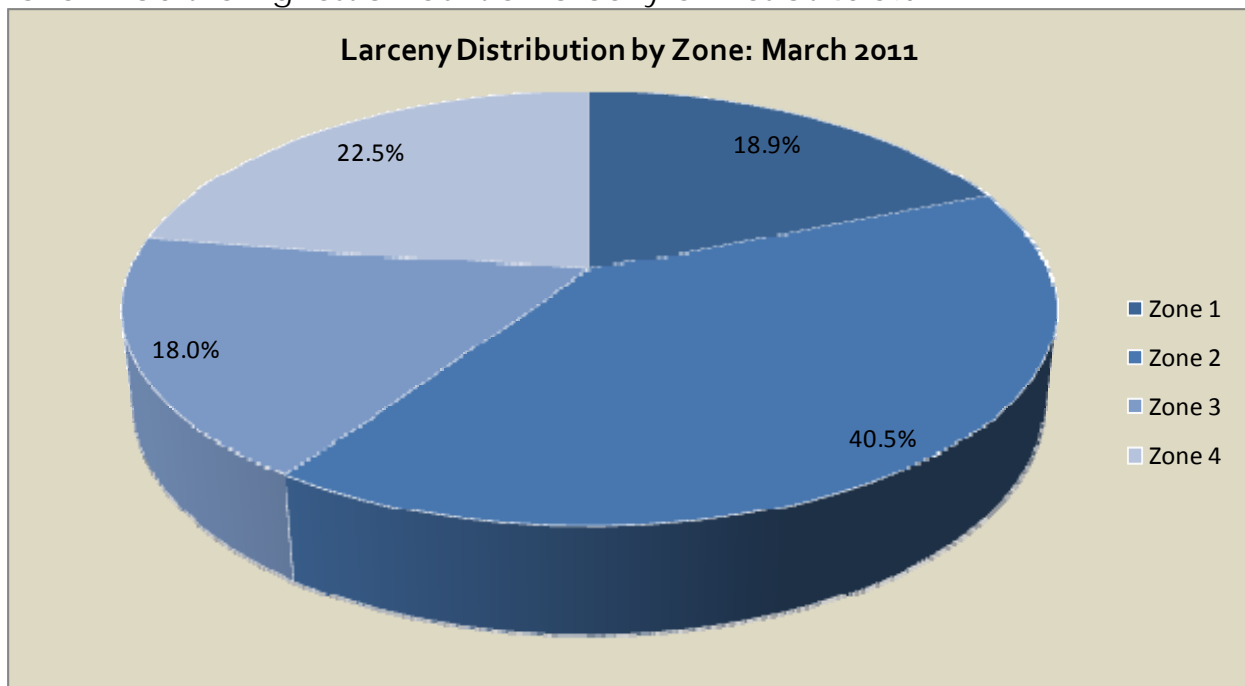
Zone 2 had the highest amount of Property Crimes at **32.7%**



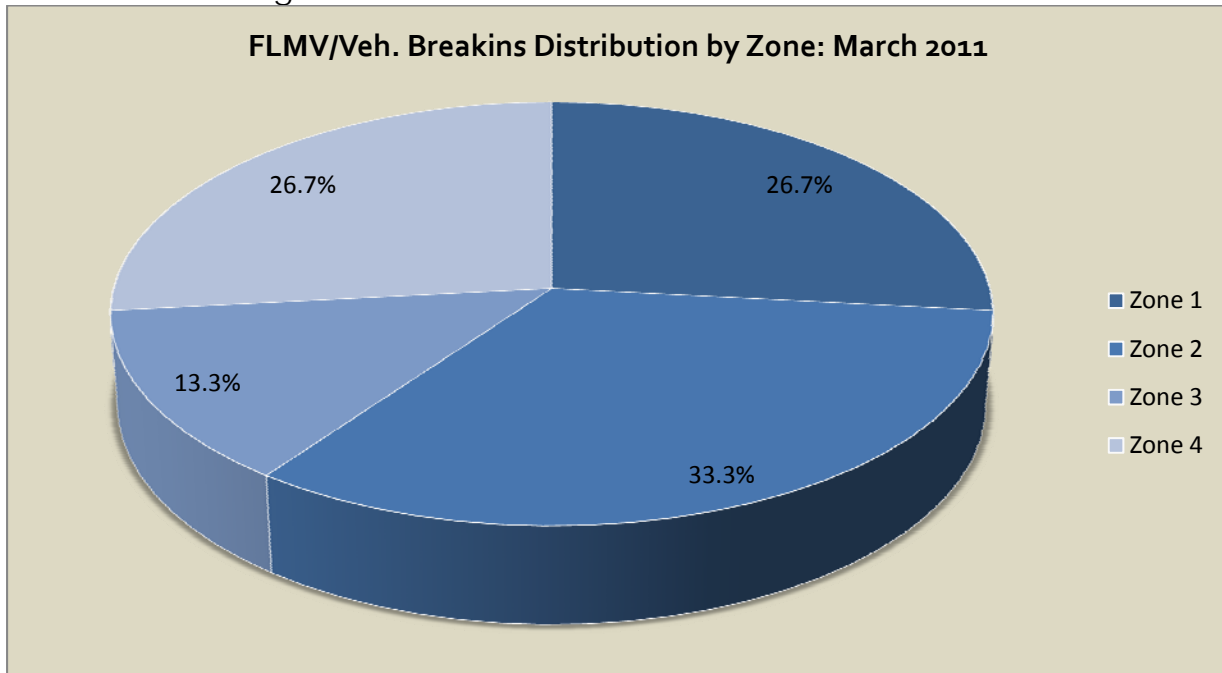
22 Violent Crimes reported were distributed by Zone as follows:
Zone 3 and **Zone 4** had the highest amount of Violent Crimes at **31.8%**



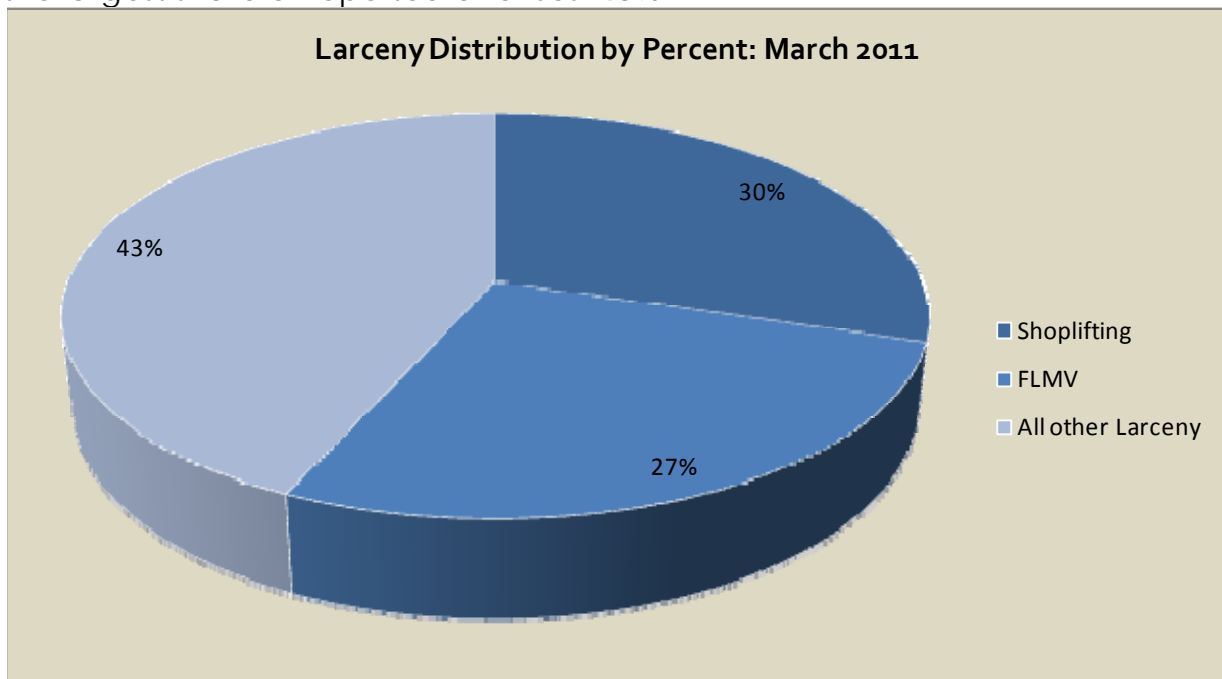
The **111** Larcenies reported in March '11 are distributed as follows:
Zone 2 had the highest amount of Larceny Crimes at **40.5%**



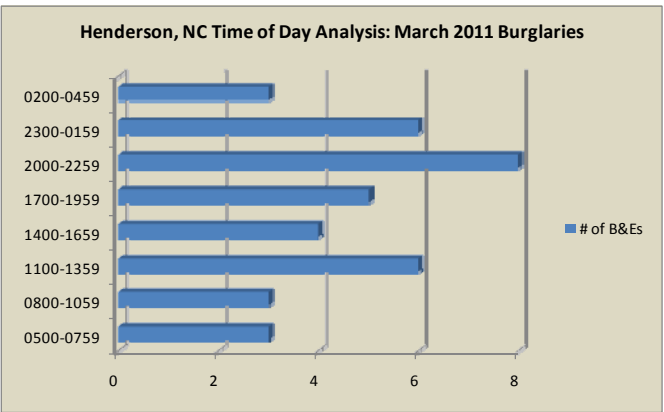
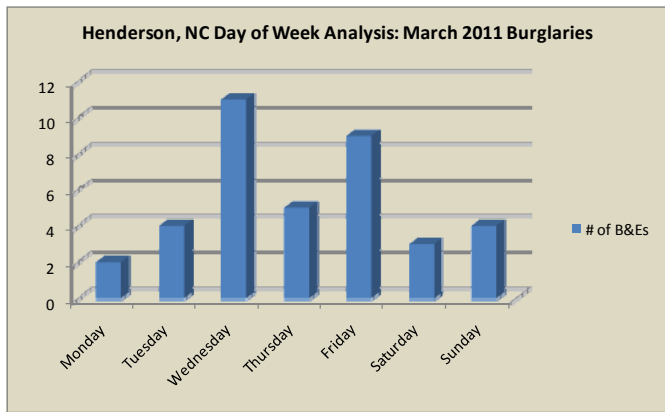
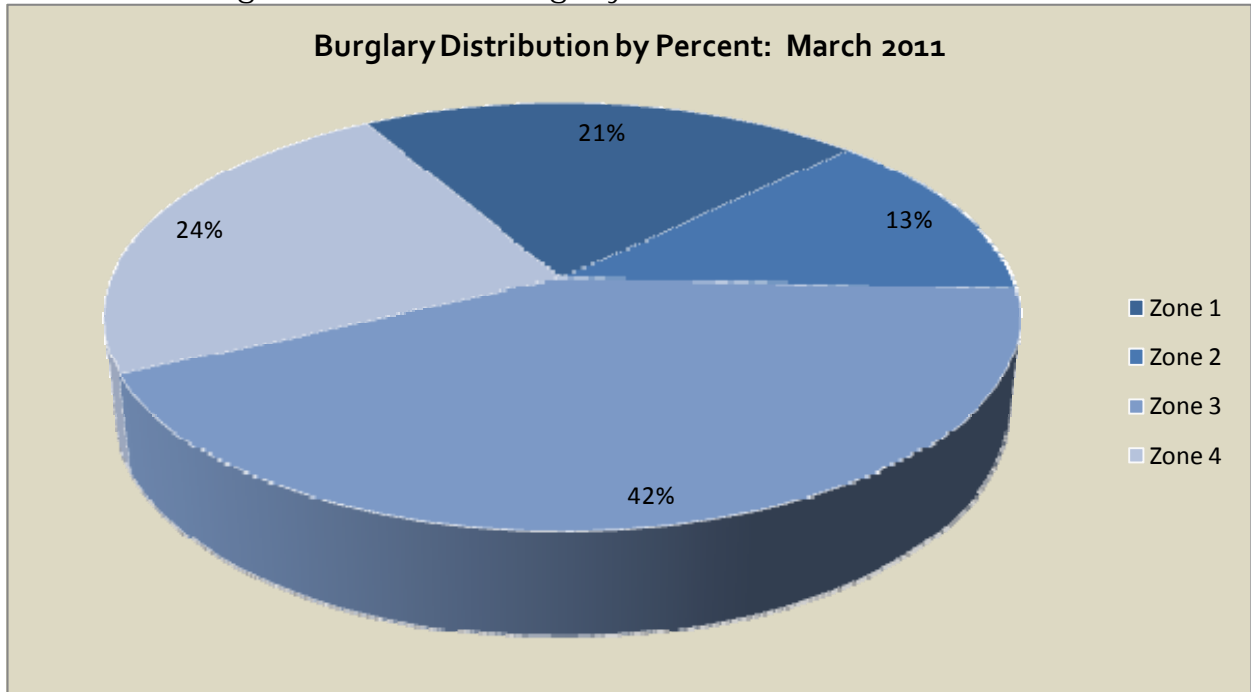
The **30** FLMV/Vehicle Break-ins reported in March '11 are distributed as follows:

Environmental Conditions at Crash

The majority of crashes are occurring in daylight hours (67.1%) and in dry (87.1%) and clear (80%) conditions.

Contributing Factors:

The main contributing causes of crashes was : No contributing circumstances indicated (36.05%)

The 2nd most contributing causes of crashes was : Inattention (18.60%)

The 3rd most contributing causes of crashes was : Improper Backing (8.72%)

The 4th most contributing causes of crashes was : Failure to Reduce Speed & Other (5.81%)
